ORDER

UPON informal request of the Respondent First Nations Child and Family Caring Society of Canada [Caring Society] on behalf of the parties, by letter dated September 16, 2026, for an order establishing a timetable for remaining steps with respect to the Confederacy of Treaty Six First Nations' [CT6FN] motion for leave to intervene filed September 3, 2026, under Rules 109 and 369 of the *Federal Courts Rules*, SOR/98-106 [*Rules*];

CONSIDERING the facts and submissions relevant to the request as set out in the said letter;

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Applicant

CONSIDERING that the Applicant Attorney General of Canada, the Respondents the Assembly of First Nations, Canadian Human Rights Commission, Chiefs of Ontario and Nishnawbe Aski Nation, and the Moving Party CT6FN, consent to the timeline for remaining steps in the motion for leave to intervene, consistent with Rule 7 of the *Rules*, and that the Respondent Amnesty International Canada takes no position;

CONSIDERING that the Applicant served and filed its responding record under Rule 369(2) of the *Rules* on September 14, 2026;

AND CONSIDERING that the consent timetable for the underlying Application, filed on September 2, 2026, did not provide for the motion for leave to intervene filed on September 3, 2026;

THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. The Respondents shall serve and file their responding motion records pursuant to Rule 369(2) of the *Rules*, with proof of service, by no later than **September 21, 2026**.
2. The Moving Party CT6FN shall serve and file any written representations in reply pursuant to Rule 369(3) of the *Rules*, with proof of service, by no later than **September 24, 2026**.
3. The parties may request an extension of time of the above deadlines by letter, if on consent or unopposed, or otherwise by requesting a case management conference.
